

**NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES IN THE
REGULATIONS OF THE
ALASKA COMMISSION ON POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION**

The Alaska Commission on Postsecondary Education proposes to change regulations relating to the Alaska state financial aid programs and to the authorization of postsecondary institutions operating in Alaska

The Alaska Commission on Postsecondary Education proposes to adopt regulation changes in Title 20 Chapters 15, 16 and 17 of the Alaska Administrative Code dealing with regulations of the Alaska state financial aid programs (AS 14.43) and regulations relating to the authorization of postsecondary institutions operating in Alaska (AS 14.48), including the following:

- update Editor's Note to reflect the Alaska Commission on Postsecondary Education's new web page address (20 AAC 15.140);
- update reference to federal poverty guidelines (20 AAC 15.915);
- add a subsection to clarify the distribution of reserved grant funds (20 AAC 16.034);
- clarify eligibility requirements for postsecondary education institutions' exemption from authorization (20 AAC 17.015)
- amend institutional standards for converting credit hours (20 AAC 17.060); and
- make general housekeeping and conforming changes.

You may comment on the proposed regulation changes, including the potential costs to private persons of complying with the proposed changes, by submitting written comments to the Executive Director of the Alaska Commission on Postsecondary Education, P. O. Box 110505, Juneau, Alaska 99811-0505, or ACPE.ExecDirector@Alaska.gov. Comments received are a public record. The comments must be received no later than 4:30 p.m. on September 16, 2013. Education will either adopt these or other provisions dealing with the same subject, without further notice, or decide to take no action on them. The language of the final regulations may be different from that of the proposed regulations. **YOU SHOULD COMMENT DURING THE TIME ALLOWED IF YOUR INTERESTS COULD BE AFFECTED.**
